RESORT POLICIES

These policies have been compiled for the enjoyment and safety of all our guests. We ask that you use courteous camping practices and respect your camping neighbor to make your stay a pleasant one. If you have a question that's not answered here, please see one of our team members.

1. The Speed limit throughout the entire campground is **5 mph**. Please drive carefully and watch out for children.

2. Check-in time is **2:00 p.m**.. Check-out time is **11:00 a.m**. If you wish to stay an extra night, please register at the office prior to 10:00 a.m. to verify availability. There is an early check-in fee of \$10/hr prior to 2 p.m. Please leave your site as clean as you found it.

3. Quiet hours are from **10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m**. Please ask that visitors depart by 10:00 p.m. All music and televisions should be turned off and voices down to whisper. Excessive noise will not be allowed. Late arrivals need to be in and set up by 10:00 p.m.

4. Visitors using the pool or spending the night are required to check-in at the office and pay prior to visiting the campsite or the pool.

5. Pool hours are from **10:00 a.m.-Dusk**. Our pool is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day. All children under 14 must have a parent or guardian with them since there is no lifeguard on duty. We ask that you not bring food or glass containers in the pool area. There is a picnic area just outside the fenced-in area of the pool for your use.

6. Pets are an important part of your family. Please remember to keep pets on a leash at all times (exception in dog park) and clean up after your pet. Registered service dogs only allowed in bath houses and pool area. Pets aren't allowed to be left in any of our structures unattended, including rental cottages, cabins, a-frames, and tents. Excessive barking will not be allowed.

7. Do not cut any trees: fallen, dead or alive. Please **do not remove** any of the wood from any area of the campground.

8. Fire pits are provided at every campsite. Please do not move fire pits or fire rings. Campfires must be kept under control and extinguished by midnight.

9. Due to environmental concerns, please don't bring firewood with you. We sell native firewood at the campground and can deliver it to your site (from a vendor in Door County).

10. Please Extinguish your campfire prior to leaving your site or retiring for the evening.

11. Accompany all children **under 14** when using the showers. If you have been using the pool, please remember to towel off prior to using the facilities.

12. Use the spigots at your campsite or the ones provided throughout the campground to wash your dishes. Do not wash dishes in the bathroom sinks.

13. We ask that you use the dumpsters located behind the office to dispose of your trash. Do not leave garbage outside at your site overnight. We will pick up bagged trash from your site from 9am to 12 noon. Do not leave trash outside overnight.

14. Park your automobile on your campsite only. If you need to use overflow parking check in with the office. Please do not park on the grass.

15. Please use the roads and paths provided in the campground.

16. Playground closes at Dusk. All children 14 and under must have a parent or guardian accompany them. All children must be in their campsites by 10:00 p.m.

17. Visitors are subject to additional charge. Please check in at the office for assistance.

18. No golf carts, ATV, electric or gas scooters are allowed to be operated on the grounds.

19. No smoking in the restrooms, main office, pool area, Glamping tents, cabins, cottages, or A-Frames.

20. Do not place mats, rugs or tents on any of the grass in your campsite, it will kill our grass. Do not park on the grass.

21. There is a maximum of 4 adults per site. Or a family consisting of 2 domestic partners and their children -we allow 6 per site.

If you are unable to follow our policies listed above, you will be asked to leave the campground- no refunds/no exceptions.
