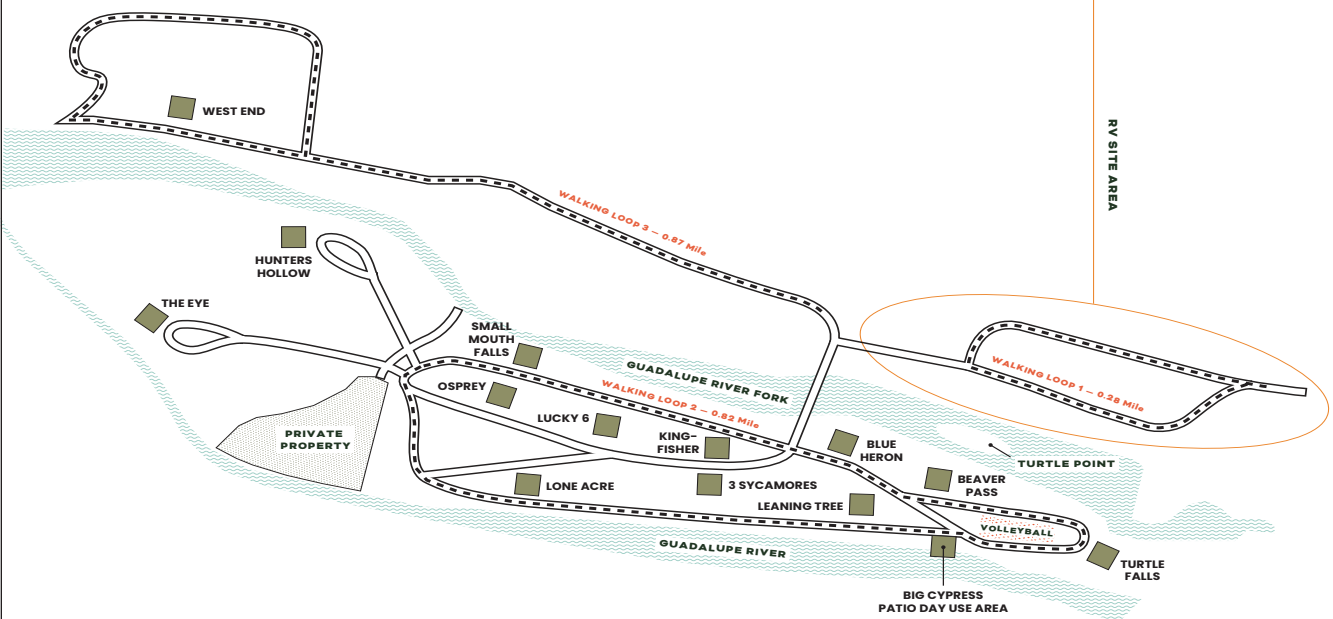
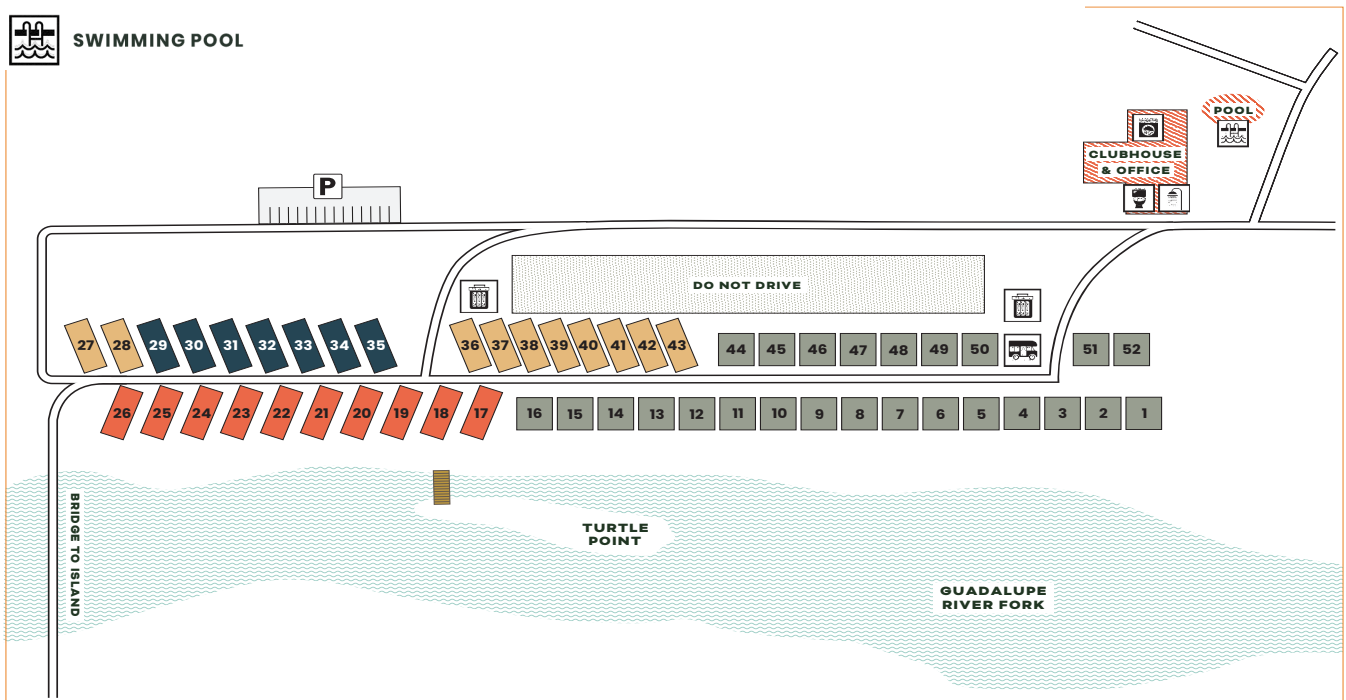

LOCAL HIGHLIGHTS

GUADALUPE RIVER

Located right next to the campgrounds, Guadalupe River is perfect for rafting, canoeing, kayaking, and paddleboarding.

STONEHENGE II AT THE HILL COUNTRY ARTS FOUNDATION
