RESORT POLICIES

CHECK IN /OUT

RV/Tent/Rustic Cabin Check-In: 1:00 PM Mountain Time Lodge/Creekside Cabin/Cozy Cabin Check-In: 3:00 PM Mountain Time Check-Out: 11:00 AM Mountain Time (we do not allow late checkout.)

10:00pm to 8:00am. Any activity that may disturb other guests is not allowed. Disruptive guests will be asked to leave without refund.

PET POLICY

Pets are welcome at the campground. You may have up to 2 pets in the park. Please leash your pet at all times while walking the park and do not leave tied up or unattended.

RESTROOMS, SHOWERS AND LAUNDRY ROOM

Closed daily 11 AM - 1 PM for cleaning.

No wood campfires. No Tiki or fuel torches. All types of fireworks are prohibited. Propane and charcoal are allowed, and must not be left unattended. Fire pits, grills, and other open-flame devices shall not be operated on cabin decks or picnic tables.

TRASH

Due to frequent bear activity, outdoor trash containers are not permitted. Trash must be removed from the site and taken to the BEAR-PROOF dumpster, which is locked every night at 9 PM.

Unacceptable items placed in the dumpster or left behind in the campsite will result in a \$25 - \$100 disposal fee: i.e. appliances, tv, grill, mattress, furniture, dog beds, carpets, tents, cigarette butts, etc.

LOCAL HIGHLIGHTS

MESA VERDE NATIONAL PARK

Known for its well-preserved Ancestral Puebloan cliff dwellings, notably the huge Cliff Palace. The Chapin Mesa Archeological Museum has exhibits on the ancient Native American culture.

DRY FORK TRAIL

The Dry Fork Trail system a short 3.5 miles from Lightner Creek Campground and is a popular trail for hikers and mountain bikers. It is a 12 mile loop that links up with the Colorado Trail system.

DURANGO & SILVERTON NARROW GAUGE TRAIN

Established in 1881, this authentic steam-powered, coal-fired scenic railroad makes daily trips through the remote mountains between Durango and Silverton.
