LOCAL HIGHLIGHTS

ECHO LAKE

It has some of the most crystal-clear water of any lake in Maine, which makes it feel even more refreshing on a hot day. It's great for kayaking and canoeing, but simply relaxing along the shore is good enough for us.

ACADIA NATIONAL PARK

Acadia National Park is a 47,000-acre Atlantic coast recreation area primarily on Maine's Mount Desert Island. Its landscape is marked by woodland, rocky beaches and glacier-scoured granite peaks such as Cadillac Mountain, the highest point on the United States' East Coast.

ACADIA MOUNTAIN TRAILHEAD

Head out on this 2.6-mile loop trail near Southwest Harbor, Maine. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 20 min to complete.

MOUNT DESERT ISLAND

Mount Desert Island (MDI) is the largest island off the coast of Maine. Widely known as the home of Acadia National Park and the town of Bar Harbor, it draws millions of visitors each year.
