CHECK IN / OUT

RV/Tent Check-In: 2:00 PM Mountain Time Cabin Check-In: 3:00 PM Mountain Time Glamping Check-In: 3:00 PM Mountain Time Check-Out: 11:00 AM on Departure Date

QUIET TIME

10:00 PM until 7:00 AM

PET POLICY

Pets are welcome at the campground. Pets must be on a leash at all times. Maximum 2 pets per RV site. No pets are allowed in Glamping Tents. Maximum 2 pets per Cabin for a nightly charge. Please pick up after pets.

SPEED LIMIT

5 mph speed limit on camp roads. All cars must display car tag, including visitors.

VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS

No ATV's, motor bikes, 3 or 4 wheelers, golf carts, motorized scooters or go-carts to be driven around the campground.

POOL/HOT TUB RULES

Open 10:00 AM - 8:00 PM Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day Kids under 14 can't swim alone and must have an adult at all times. No children under 18 in the hot tub. Swim diapers must be used. No glass.

CAMPFIRE

Instate wood only. Do not move the fire ring.

No smoking in common areas, near doorways, or inside buildings.

PUBLIC AMENITIES

BATHHOUSE

Enjoy clean bathrooms and large showers.

COIN OPERATED LAUNDRY

Keep your gear fresh and clean during your stay. Quarters are available in the office.

ON-SITE ACTIVITIES

LOCAL HIGHLIGHTS

MOUNT RUSHMORE

Majestic figures of George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln, surrounded by the beauty of the Black Hills of South Dakota.

CUSTER STATE PARK

Encompassing 71,000 acres in the Black Hills, Custer State Park is home to abundant wildlife and adventure; camping, hiking, biking, swimming, fishing, or relaxing, there's something here for everyone.

CRAZY HORSE MEMORIAL

Crazy Horse is the world's largest mountain carving located in the Black Hills of South Dakota. It is considered The Eighth Wonder of the World in progress.

JEWEL CAVE NATIONAL MONUMENT

Immerse yourself within the third longest cave in the world. With over 210 miles of mapped and surveyed passages, this underground wilderness appeals to human curiosity.

BADLANDS NATIONAL PARK

These striking geologic deposits contain one of the world's richest fossil beds. Ancient horses and rhinos once roamed here. The park's 244,000 acres protect an expanse of mixed-grass prairie where bison, bighorn sheep, prairie dogs, and black-footed ferrets live today.
